And, as always, there are links to helpful and thought-provoking articles, cool and fun downloadable freebies, yummy recipes, and much more.






May Day

Traditionally, the 1st of May marks the beginning of the summer season (halfway point between the spring equinox and summer solstice) and was commemorated with spring festivals, dancing, and flowers. It was rooted in agriculture, celebrating sown fields beginning to sprout. Cattle were driven to pasture, special bonfires were lit, and doors of houses as well as livestock were decorated with yellow May flowers. In the Middle Ages, the Gaelic people celebrated the festival of Beltane. Beltane means "Day of Fire." People created large bonfires and danced at night to celebrate.


